Science:	<p>Materials: Rocks and soil Observing the appearance and physical properties of rocks, children compare and group different rock samples. They learn about how fossils and soils are formed and record soil drainage rates in a bar chart</p> <p>Energy: Light and shadows Identifying examples of light sources, children learn that light is needed to see and how its absence causes darkness. Children investigate reflection and shadow formation, including how different factors change the shadows observed. They explore how shadows can be used to entertain in the arts and create shadow puppets to recount how different people work or experiment with light.</p>
