# Agreement for Families

To help myself at school I will do my best to:

- Follow the school rules, Ready, Respectful, Safe
- Be a good friend and show friendship to others
- Be polite, respectful and helpful to others
- Keep myself and others safe
- Use appropriate language while in school
- Persevere and do my best in all of my lessons
- Talk at home about the things I learn at school
- Read at home five times a week and do my homework
- Bring my book bag and reading book to school everyday
- Talk to a grown up if I am unhappy or worried about anything
- Use positive behaviours in school and help other children to do the same
- Treat the school environment and equipment in the school, with respect.

To help your child at school, we will do our best to:

- Keep your child safe
- Deliver a broad, balanced and inclusive curriculum which meets the needs of your child
- Ensure your child receives their entitlement to 190 school days in which to learn
- Work with you to promote and support high levels of attendance
- Set a planned programme of appropriate homework activities which supports learning
- Contact you as soon as possible if we have any concerns about your child's punctuality, attendance or behaviour
- Keep you fully informed of your child's progress through regular meetings
- Provide targeted support to help your child keep up, or catch up, with Maths and English
- Keep you informed about school matters and the curriculum
- Provide a range of activities to enrich your child's learning experience
- Provide purposeful continued professional development for staff so we can be the best we can be in our roles.
- Seek help and advice from other professionals to support you and your child as required

To help our child at school, we will do our best to:

- Ensure that our child attends school each day (unless unwell) and arrives promptly to start lessons
- Notify school as soon as possible if our child is unexpectedly absent (e.g. sickness)
- Book medical appointments outside of the school day where possible
- Only request leave of absence (in advance) for exceptional circumstances
- Ensure that our child has all that they need for school
- Support our child at home as they complete their homework activities, read 5 times a week and talk about what they have been learning
- Ensure that our child wears the school uniform as set out in the school policy
- Attend Parents Evenings and discussions about our child's progress
- Support meetings based upon the work of the school
- Work with the school to ensure that our child behaves well
- Keep the school informed of any circumstances that might affect our child
- Comply with school policies and rules to ensure all children are kept safe
