



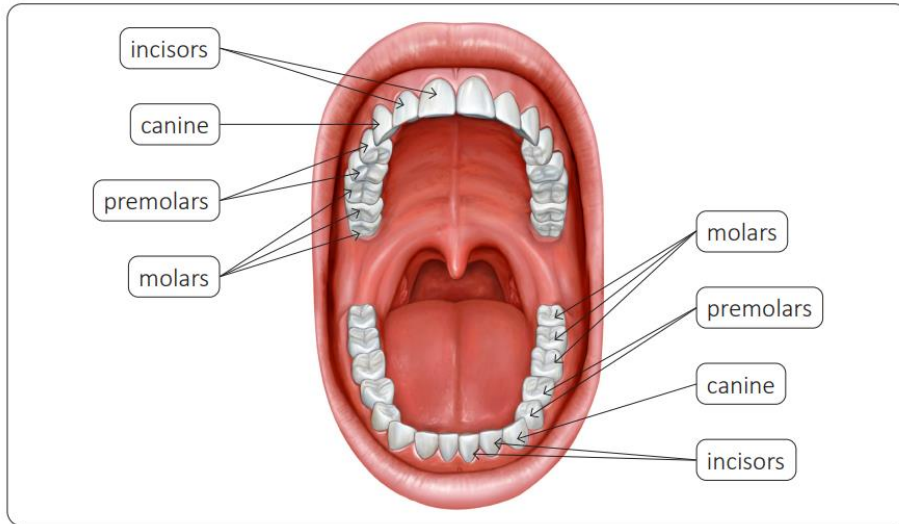


## Kingfishers Term 2 homework grid

<p>1. Science Complete a dental survey of your family. How many incisors, canines, pre-molars, molars and wisdom teeth do each member of your family have?</p>		<p>2. TOPIC Use the internet to search for pictures of the artefacts found at the Sutton Hoo burial site, such as The Franks casket, purse lid and shoulder clasp. Create a piece of Anglo-Saxon art using the designs on the artefacts as inspiration.</p>	<p>3. TOPIC Use the table below and a map of the United Kingdom to identify Anglo-Saxon place names. Explain what you think each place might have been used for or how it got its name. Visit 'The University of Nottingham – Key to English Place Names' website to find out more about the origins of place names.</p>
<p>4. TOPIC Use a range of historical source materials to research what everyday life was like in Anglo-Saxon or Viking Britain. Areas to research might include clothing, housing, food, culture and religion. Create a labelled poster, non-chronological report, blog or presentation to present your findings.</p>		<p>5. TOPIC Imagine you are monk at Lindisfarne, who witnessed the Viking attacks on the monastery. Write a diary entry explaining what you saw and include your thoughts and feelings about the attack. Or draw a picture to represent the attack.</p>	<p>6. TOPIC Research a significant Anglo-Saxon or Viking figure from the list below and create a fact file or biography about your chosen individual.</p>
<p>7. TOPIC Pretend you are an Anglo-Saxon or Viking ruler for the day. What rules would you create? What kind of leader would you be?</p>		<p>8. TOPIC Use a range of resources to create a knowledge organiser about the Battle of Hastings. Include details about key dates, people and events and a paragraph to explain why this battle was so significant for England. Or draw and label some of the weapons and artefacts they may have used.</p>	<p>9. TOPIC Finish your home learning by writing a summary of the topic, explaining what you have learned about invasion in the early Middle Ages.</p>
<p>10. TOPIC The Vikings had many gods. Create a new God for the Vikings – create a poster. What would they be the God of? What would be their special powers? Would they have a special animal or object that helped them?</p>		<p>11. MATHS Practise addition: Choose 4 or 5 items from a shopping receipt to add together. Remember to use place value columns and written methods for addition. Use a calculator to check your answers.</p>	<p>12. MATHS Play the dice game. Start with 3 points. Choose a target number (e.g. 30) Roll a 1,2 or 3 to subtract 1, 2 or 3 from your points. Roll a 4, 5 or 6 to add 4, 5 or 6 to your points. The winner is the first person to reach your target number. Alternatively, create you own addition and subtraction game.</p>
